



BAY CITY ACADEMY SCHOOL BUS RULES

All students must observe the following bus regulations. Rules are designed with the safety of our passengers in mind. It is critical that students cooperate with other passengers, bus drivers and all school personnel to ensure safe transportation for all students.

1. Students will obey the driver and occupy the seat assigned by the driver at ALL times. Assigned seats are subject to change.
2. Students will be seated when the bus is in motion.
3. Students will sit on the seat of the bus, face the front and keep feet and all personal belongings out of the aisle.
4. Students will keep ALL body parts and items inside the bus at all times.
5. Eating and/or drinking is not allowed on the school bus.
6. Students will keep hair spray, perfumes, deodorants, or other types of sprays in their backpacks.
7. Students will use appropriate language and gestures.
8. Fighting, pushing, shoving and horseplay are strictly prohibited.
9. Remember, the bus driver is responsible for driving the bus and also has complete authority over the conduct of all passengers. All passengers must follow the above rules and any other instructions given by the bus driver to ensure the safety of all persons involved. If at any time a student fails to follow instructions or violates bus rules, the driver will file a written bus conduct report. These reports will result in a warning notice to parents of the violator and/or suspension of transportation services.
